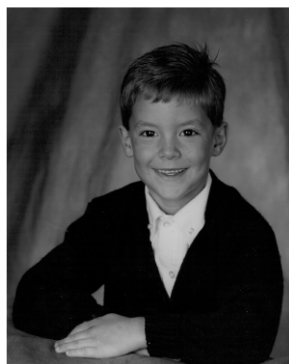

It has been 12 years since we have seen his bright shining face. A face full of hope, charisma and compassion. Corey Stump was a fun loving 8-year-old boy who loved soccer, riding his bike to the Alsace Park and doing the things all 8-year-old boys liked to do. Corey learned young what it meant to be compassionate when his brother Justin became ill at the age of 4 and battled multiple seizures daily. Corey would go to school at Berks Christian and pray for his brother every morning. Anyone that knew Corey, knew he was destined to be something great, he was one of a kind.

On that fateful day when we lost him, we lost the opportunity to see what a fine person he would become. Corey was on a bike ride to the Alsace Park with friends when he was hit by a pick up truck. The injuries he sustained tragically ended his young life. However, even after death, Corey was able to help others when his parents decided to donate some of his organs. They knew that even at such a young age, he would want to help someone in need.

Who knows what kind of greatness he would have embarked on. However, we know that he is always smiling down on those he loved and lives within us everyday. The Alsace Park was dedicated in 2000 with a Corey Stump Memorial Plaque. It is our hope to keep the playground and community strong that Corey loved so much by raising money for much needed improvements.

~ Prizes will be awarded to the top male and female overall and runner-up male and female over all plus age group awards: 3males/ 3females in each category: 14 and under, 15-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, and 60+.

~ A raffle will also take place for ALL participants. The raffle consists of prizes donated by local business and will begin after the last walker has returned to the park.

~ During and after the race/walk there will be plenty of family fun for those who don't participate but would like to lend their support. We will have some child friendly games, crafts, and food.

~This event is an effort to revitalize a park and bring it up to date to meet the needs of the children in the Alsace community. It is our goal to make this day a family fun event for all who attend. Please help us in remembering Corey and make him a lasting positive memory in the community.

~This is a rolling but fair 5k course, wheel-measured and allows you to see runner in mid-race by only walking 50-100 yards from the starting line.
